- Camp begins at 8:00 a.m. Buses depart promptly at 8:15 a.m.
- The BCFD takes no responsibility in the safe-keeping of personal items.
- Always tell a group leader when you check-in in the morning and check-out in the evening.
- Always stay with your group and/or group leader.
- Always tell a group leader when you are going to use the restroom.
- Always be courteous and cooperative.
- Camp participants should remember to play safe and use good sportsmanship.
- Report anything wrong to a group leader or camp staff.
- Wear and bring sunscreen if needed.
- Camp participants will walk together to the bus/van.
- Camp participants will enter the bus/van in an orderly line when the driver or group leader directs them to do so. (No running)
- Nothing shall be put outside the windows of the bus/van – May be cause for dismissal from camp.
- Windows shall be opened only with the permission driver or group leader.
- Littering will not be tolerated on the bus/van or at any of the facilities that are visited during the camp.
- Camp participants will be expected to follow the rules of the site being visited. (Site rules will be reviewed before each trip)
- Foul language or verbal abuse will not be tolerated - May be cause for dismissal from camp.
- Any form of physical fighting will not be tolerated - May be cause for dismissal from camp.
- Horseplay is not allowed – May be cause for dismissal from camp.
- ***Most importantly - HAVE FUN!!!***

Note to Parents/ Guardians:

- Any child experiencing behavioral problems on a field trip may be excluded from the next field trip or dismissed from the camp.
- All campers must wear their BCFD T-shirts during the camp. (T-shirts are provided **FREE** of charge. Please keep in mind that we have a limited supply of T-shirts.)
- **Please bring appropriate swim attire and a towel on Friday July 28, 2017**
